TREE NOMINATION FORM

Anybody can nominate and measure a tree!

When nominating a tree, you must obtain these three measurements.

Trunk **Circumference** measured at 1.4m above the ground, in metres to nearest cm. e.g. 5.13, 5.50, 3.20

Tree **Height** measured in metres to nearest metre. e.g. 35 [35.20], 16 [15.50], 83 [83]. Under 10m to nearest half metre e.g. 6 [6.2], 7.5 [7.6].

Average **Crown Spread** measured in metres to nearest metre above. e.g. 16 [15.20], 6 [5.50], 25 [25]
